Ritual Backpack for a Mountain Ascetic

The structure was fragile due to lacquer flaking and missing/detached components, making even moving it difficult. To preserve it in better condition for the future, measures were taken to prevent further flaking, reinforce the structure and materials, and supplement missing parts.



Storage Facility Fumigation

Pests and mold had appeared in the treasure repository, posing a risk of damage and contamination. Given the extreme urgency of the situation, we immediately carried out fumigation and cleaning of the interior to restore the storage environment to normal conditions.
